ORDER CLARIFYING HEARING
DATES AND DENYING REQUEST
FOR STATUS CONFERENCE

On July 23, 2012, the undersigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued an Order granting a continuance in this matter and setting October 9, 2012, at 9:30 AM as the date for the due process hearing.

On September 13, 2012, the Templeton Unified School District (District) filed a request for clarification of that order because it does not specify additional hearing days.

The original Order should have specified additional hearing days. The Order of July 23, 2012, is amended to read that the due process hearing will commence on October 9, 2012, and will continue from day to day until the hearing is concluded, unless otherwise ordered by the ALJ presiding over the proceedings.

The District's request for a status conference is denied, as no unusual circumstances have been presented that would warrant a status conference. It is not the Office of Administrative Hearing's role to inquire whether Student has obtained an attorney yet or to rule on a hypothetical future request for a continuance.
