ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR  
CONTINUANCE AND SETTING  
PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND  
DUE PROCESS HEARING

On August 10, 2012, counsel for the Saugus Union School District filed with the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) a request to continue the initially scheduled hearing dates in the case, based upon the unavailability of key witnesses. On August 14, 2012, Parent filed with OAH a request for continuance, based upon the need to perform assessments of Student. Also on August 14, 2012, counsel for the District responded to Parent's request, agreeing that a continuance is warranted.

A due process hearing must be conducted and a decision rendered within 45 days of receipt of the due process notice unless an extension is granted for good cause. (34 C.F.R. § 300.515(a) & (c) (2006); Ed. Code, §§ 56502, subd. (f), 56505, subd. (f)(3); Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1020.)

OAH has reviewed the request for good cause and considered all relevant facts and circumstances. The request is: Granted. All dates are vacated. This matter will be set as follows:

Mediation:	To be determined by the parties.
Prehearing Conference:	10/22/2012, at 1:30 p.m.
Due Process Hearing:	10/29/2012 at 1:30 p.m.; 10/30/2012; 10/31/2012; 11/01/2012, and continuing day to day, Monday through Thursday, as needed at the discretion of the Administrative Law Judge.
