ORDER REGARDING PROCESS OF
FILING DOCUMENTS

On December 17, 2012, Derek E. Backus, attorney for the California Department of Health Care Services (Health Care), filed a motion to change venue in this matter. OAH does not currently accept filing of documents via email and any document sent via email, in the future, may not be accepted for filing by OAH.¹
