On October 17, 2012, the parties, except for the California Children's Services, engaged in mediation before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH), and requested a continuance of the initially scheduled hearing dates in this matter, based upon an interim agreement reached during mediation.

A due process hearing must be conducted and a decision rendered within 45 days of receipt of the due process notice unless an extension is granted for good cause. (34 C.F.R. § 300.515(a) & (c) (2006); Ed. Code, §§ 56502, subd. (f), 56505, subd. (f)(3); Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1020.) OAH has reviewed the request for good cause and considered all relevant facts and circumstances. The request is: Granted. All dates are vacated. This matter will be set as follows:

Prehearing Conference:	01/23/2012, at 10:00 a.m.
Due Process Hearing:	01/29/2013; 01/30/2013; 01/31/2013, and continuing day to day, Monday through Thursday, as needed at the discretion of the Administrative Law Judge.
