ORDER REGARDING  
CORRESPONDENCE WITH THE  
OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE  
HEARINGS

On September 11, 2013, Mr. Roger Greenbaum, Attorney at Law, representing Student and Parent in the above captioned matters, submitted several documents to the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) via email. The emails were sent, unsolicited, to OAH's staff counsel. These documents were incorrectly filed, as OAH does not accept filings via email. On October 1, 2013, Mr. Greenbaum faxed into OAH an opposition to a motion for sanctions. While the motion was filed properly by facsimile, Mr. Greenbaum again directed the document to OAH's staff counsel, as well as two other staff members.

Mr. Greenbaum is hereby directed to refrain from contacting OAH's staff counsel and to file documents with OAH via facsimile or US mail. All documents in the above captioned cases should be directed to ALJ Margaret Broussard and no other OAH staff member.

Mr. Greenbaum is further instructed to direct correspondence in any other case in front of OAH to the assigned ALJ, or if the case has not been assigned to an ALJ, simply to OAH. OAH will determine which staff member will receive the correspondence.
