ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR  
CONTINUANCE AND SETTING  
PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND  
DUE PROCESS HEARING

On November 13, 2012, the educational advocate for Student filed with the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) a request to continue the initially scheduled hearing dates in the case, based upon a medical condition of Student's mother. On November 15, 2012, counsel for the District filed with OAH an opposition to the request. OAH normally grants continuance requests of initially scheduled dates, and the parties are encouraged to meet and confer about mutually convenient dates in the event there is disagreement about the following continuation dates.

A due process hearing must be conducted and a decision rendered within 45 days of receipt of the due process notice unless an extension is granted for good cause. (34 C.F.R. § 300.515(a) & (c) (2006); Ed. Code, §§ 56502, subd. (f), 56505, subd. (f)(3); Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1020.) OAH has reviewed the request for good cause and considered all relevant facts and circumstances. The request is: Granted. All dates are vacated. This matter will be set as follows:
