ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR
CONTINUANCE AND SETTING

On April 24, 2013, the parties submitted to the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) a joint request to continue the prehearing conference (PHC) in this matter, based upon a negotiated settlement. The parties requested a continuance of the PHC to April 29, 2013, but OAH Special Education is in training that day. A due process hearing must be conducted and a decision rendered within 45 days of receipt of the due process notice unless an extension is granted for good cause. (34 C.F.R. § 300.515(a) & (c) (2006); Ed. Code, §§ 56502, subd. (f), 56505, subd. (f)(3); Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1020.) OAH has reviewed the request for good cause and considered all relevant facts and circumstances. The request is: Granted. All dates are vacated. This matter will be set as follows:
