ORDER FOR SUPPLEMENTAL
INFORMATION ON MOTION TO
DISMISS

On February 21, 2013, El Camino Real Charter High School (ECRCHS) filed a motion to dismiss ECRCHS asserting that ECRCHS is not the public educational agency responsible for providing special education services to Student. No opposition from Student or Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) has been received. Additional information is required before a ruling may be made on the pleadings.

ORDER

No later than the close of business on Friday, March 8, 2013, ECRCHS and LAUSD shall provide information regarding the legal relationship between ECRCHS and LAUSD for all times relevant to the issues raised in Student's complaint. At a minimum, this information should include the status of ECRCHS as a local education agency, agreements between ECRCHS and LAUSD regarding the provision of special education services and any agreements between ECRCHS and LAUSD relating to defense of claims made under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act. Each party shall include sworn declarations and other documentary evidence supporting any factual assertions included in its briefing.
