ORDER VACATING HEARING
DATES AND SETTING TELEPHONIC
STATUS CONFERENCE

This matter is set for a due process hearing to begin before the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) on Wednesday, April 3, 2013. On April 2, 2013, the parties notified OAH by telephone messages of a pending settlement and Acting Presiding Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Deidre L. Johnson, thereafter conducted a telephone status conference. Attorney Brett Allen appeared on behalf of Student and Parents (Student). Attorney Lenore Silverman appeared as counsel for the Oakland Unified School District (District). The conference was not recorded. The parties represented that they have settled the case and signed a written settlement agreement subject to approval by the District's governing Board. Ms. Silverman confirmed that the settlement is scheduled to be presented to the Board on or before April 24, 2012.

OAH has reviewed the request for good cause and considered all relevant facts and circumstances. The request is:

Granted. The case is continued and all dates are vacated. OAH sets conferences for the status of final settlement agreements on Wednesdays. If the agreement is not approved, it will be rescheduled for hearing. This matter is therefore set as follows:
