ORDER GRANTING JOINT REQUEST  
TO CONTINUE PREHEARING  
CONFERENCE TO MAY 29, 2013,  
AND SCHEDULE FOR FILING PHC  
STATEMENTS (CORRECTED)

On May 16, 2013, Parent on behalf of Student and the Los Angeles Unified School District (District) filed a stipulation and joint request to continue the scheduled prehearing conference (PHC) of Monday, May 20, 2013, to Wednesday, May 29, 2013. Further, the parties stipulated to a request to extend the timeline for the filing of PHC statement and prehearing motions to May 28, 2013. The parties do not request a continuance of the hearing, which is scheduled for June 4, 5, and 6.<sup>1</sup>

The parties request the PHC continuance because they are engaged in settlement discussions and do not wish to unnecessarily incur the expense and time associated with preparing and filing PHC statements. Since the parties do not seek a continuance of the hearing, the requirement of holding the hearing within 45 days of receipt of the due process notice is not disturbed. OAH considers all relevant facts and circumstances, including the proximity of the hearing date, in consider if good cause exists for a continuance.. (See Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1332(d).)

OAH has reviewed the request for good cause and considered all relevant facts and circumstances. The request is to consider the PHC is granted as follows:

1. The PHC is continued to 1:30, p.m., May 29, 2013.
2. The PHC statements, or the request for withdraw following settlement, must be filed by noon, May 28, 2013.
