ORDER VACATING HEARING
DATES AND NOTICE OF
TELEPHONIC STATUS
CONFERENCE

On May 30, 2013, Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Clifford H. Woosley convened the third day of the due process hearing in this matter. Attorney Deborah L. Pepaj appeared on behalf of Student; attorney Carlos M. Gonzalez appeared on behalf of Pasadena Unified School District (District). The parties stated that they were in the midst of negotiations which would likely result in a full settlement and, therefore, requested that the hearing be delayed while they pursued further discussions. ALJ Woosley continued the matter for an hour, at which time the hearing would resume if the parties were unable to settle.

The parties later informed ALJ Woosley that an agreement had been reached. Accordingly, the parties reduced the agreement to writing. The agreement was reviewed by the parties with their attorneys. The parties executed the agreement.

ALJ Woosley convened the hearing, creating an official record, at which time each party confirmed a full and complete settlement of the entire due process complaint, subject to school board approval. ALJ Woosley saw the settlement agreement's fully executed signature page. The parties requested that the remaining hearing dates be vacated and that the matter be scheduled for a status conference after the June 11, 2013 school board meeting.

Good cause appearing therefore, ALJ orders as follows:

1. The remaining hearing dates are vacated.
2. A telephone status conference is scheduled for **2:00 p.m., June 26, 2013**. OAH will initiate the conference call. If Student files a request for withdrawal with OAH, the status conference will be taken off calendar
