ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR  
CONTINUANCE AND SETTING  
PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND  
DUE PROCESS HEARING

On May 21, 2013, Parents, on behalf of Student, filed with the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) a request to continue the initially scheduled hearing dates in the case. On May 24, 2013, the Ramona Unified School District, through counsel, filed with OAH an opposition to this request. On May 28, 2013, Parents filed with OAH a reply to the opposition.

A due process hearing must be conducted and a decision rendered within 45 days of receipt of the due process notice unless an extension is granted for good cause. (34 C.F.R. § 300.515(a) & (c) (2006); Ed. Code, §§ 56502, subd. (f), 56505, subd. (f)(3); Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1020.) OAH has reviewed the request for good cause and considered all relevant facts and circumstances. The request is: Granted. All dates are vacated. Here, Parents have asked for time to retain an attorney to represent Student's interests in this matter. This is a basic request that is normally granted in order to provide fairness in the process. Accordingly, this matter will be set as follows:

Mediation:	To be determined by the parties.
Prehearing Conference:	07/29/2013, at 1:30 p.m.
Due Process Hearing:	08/05/2013, at 1:30 p.m.; 08/06/2013; 08/07/2013; 08/08/2013, and continuing day to day, Monday through Thursday, as needed at the discretion of the Administrative Law Judge.
