ORDER CHANGING HEARING
LOCATION AT REQUEST OF
PARTIES

On March 26, 2014, District filed a motion to change the hearing location at the request of Student to: Measure BB Building, 2828 4th Street, Santa Monica, California.

The IDEA only requires that the hearing be conducted at a place “reasonably convenient to the parent or guardian and the pupil.” (Ed. Code, § 56505, subd. (b).) Because Student agrees to the change, it is “reasonably convenient” and on that sole basis is granted.

Nothing in this Order shall be construed as interpreting the IDEA’s “reasonably convenient” location requirement to include free wi-fi, free or more convenient parking, or any particular room size or configuration.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
