ORDER GRANTING JOINT REQUEST
FOR CONTINUANCE AND SETTING
PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND
DUE PROCESS HEARING

On September 26, 2013, the parties filed a joint request to continue the dates in this matter. This is the second request for a continuance since; a first continuance was granted on June 21, 2013. With the joint request for continuance, parties stated that they are pursuing meaningful settlement negotiations and wish to avoid unnecessary expense and use of OAH resources.

A due process hearing must be conducted and a decision rendered within 45 days of receipt of the due process notice unless an extension is granted for good cause. (34 C.F.R. § 300.515(a) & (c) (2006); Ed. Code, §§ 56502, subd. (f), 56505, subd. (f)(3); Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1020.) As a result, continuances are disfavored. Good cause may include the unavailability of a party, counsel, or an essential witness due to death, illness or other excusable circumstances; substitution of an attorney when the substitution is required in the interests of justice; a party's excused inability to obtain essential testimony or other material evidence despite diligent efforts; or another significant, unanticipated change in the status of the case as a result of which the case is not ready for hearing. (See Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1332(c).) OAH considers all relevant facts and circumstances, including the proximity of the hearing date; previous continuances or delays; the length of continuance requested; the availability of other means to address the problem giving rise to the request; prejudice to a party or witness as a result of a continuance; the impact of granting a continuance on other pending hearings; whether trial counsel is engaged in another trial; whether the parties have stipulated to a continuance; whether the interests of justice are served by the continuance; and any other relevant fact or circumstance. (See Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1332(d).)

OAH has reviewed the request for continuance and considered all relevant facts and circumstances, including the parties' collaboration in agreeing upon continued dates. Good cause existing therefore, the request is granted.

All dates are vacated. This matter will be set as follows:

Prehearing Conference: **October 7, 2013**, at 3:00 PM. [PHC's are not scheduled in morning of first Monday of

month.]

Due Process Hearing:

October 14, 15 and 16, 2013, commencing at 9:00 AM, except for the first day, which shall begin at 1:30 p.m. The hearing will take place at **Office of Administrative Hearings**. The hearing shall continue day to day, Monday through Thursday, as needed at the discretion of the Administrative Law Judge.
