NOTICE OF INTENT TO TAKE NO
ACTION

On April 30, 2015, Parent, on behalf of Student, submitted a letter stating that the San Jose Unified School District was failing to implement the terms of an August 21, 2013 settlement agreement between the parties. The letter requested the Office of Administrative Hearings to provide information on what remedies were possible before OAH.

On June 28, 2013, Student filed a request for due process hearing in this matter. On August 21, 2013, the parties entered into a settlement agreement resolving their dispute, subject to approval by the Board of Trustees for San Jose. Following that approval, on September 27, 2013, Student filed a request to withdraw this matter. On October 10, 2013, OAH dismissed this matter consistent with Student's request.

As of October 10, 2013 OAH retains no jurisdiction over this matter. Therefore, OAH is providing notice to the parties that it will take no action with regard to Student's April 30, 2015 letter. If Student believes that issues exist with respect to Student's special education needs that are within the jurisdiction of OAH, Student may file a request for due process hearing, separate from this matter.
