On January 22, 2014, Parent filed with the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) a motion for continuance of the currently scheduled hearing dates in these consolidated matters. OAH treated Parent's motion as a request for accommodation under the Americans with Disabilities Act. (42 U.S.C. section 12101, et seq.) A determination was made that a continuance of the hearing to a date on after February 24, 2014, is appropriate. Therefore, Parent's request is GRANTED. (See *In re Marriage of James M. and Christine J.C.* (2008) 158 Cal.App.4th 1261.)

Accordingly, the currently scheduled hearing dates are vacated. This matter will be set as follows:

Prehearing Conference:	03/03/2014, at 1:00 p.m.
Due Process Hearing:	03/10/2014, at 1:30 p.m.; 03/11/2014; 03/12/2014; 03/13/2014, and continuing day to day, Monday through Thursday, as needed at the discretion of the Administrative Law Judge.

In the motion for continuance, Parent also requested OAH to provide attorney assistance. OAH maintains a list of attorneys and advocates for special education matters (available upon request or at the OAH website), but does not provide legal assistance or retain attorneys for parties in such cases.
