ORDER FOR SUBMISSION OF
DISTRICT EXHIBITS

On September 23, 2013, the final day of hearing in his matter was held before Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Theresa Ravandi. Daniel Shaw, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of Parent and Student (Student). Heather Edwards, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of the Roseville Joint Union High School District (District). At the close of the hearing, the ALJ reviewed with both parties on the record which exhibits had been admitted and invited counsel to make any further motions for the admission of outstanding exhibits. All other exhibits were deemed withdrawn and counsel were instructed to remove all withdrawn exhibits from the evidentiary record.

The ALJ notes that the District has removed the following admitted exhibits from its evidence binder in error: D-26, Letter from Alexander Hazel of Heritage Oaks Hospital (p. 130); D-40: Student's discipline record and referrals from 2010-2013 (pp. 171-188); and D-45: Student's attendance records from 2010-2013 (pp. 199-212). The District is ordered to submit these exhibits to the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) by Friday, October 4, 2013, with a proof of service showing that Student has been provided with a copy of each submitted exhibit. Upon receipt, the ALJ will ensure that each exhibit is returned to the District's evidence binder and remain a part of the record.¹

ORDER

By Friday, October 4, 2013, the District shall provide OAH with the following exhibits: D-26, D-40 and D-45. The District shall ensure that Student receives copies of these exhibits.
