ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR
CONTINUANCE AND SETTING
PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND
DUE PROCESS HEARING

On October 9, 2013, the parties submitted to the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) a joint request to continue and reset the initially scheduled hearing dates in the case. The parties requested a continuance of the due process hearing to January 13 – 16, 2014, but the OAH Special Education Division is in training for that week. In the event that the granted continuance dates are inconvenient, the parties may submit an additional request.

A due process hearing must be conducted and a decision rendered within 45 days of receipt of the due process notice unless an extension is granted for good cause. (34 C.F.R. § 300.515(a) & (c) (2006); Ed. Code, §§ 56502, subd. (f), 56505, subd. (f)(3); Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1020.) OAH has reviewed the request for good cause and considered all relevant facts and circumstances. The request is: Granted. All dates are vacated. This matter will be set as follows:

Mediation:	To be determined by the parties.
Prehearing Conference:	01/06/2014, at 3:00 p.m.
Due Process Hearing:	01/21/2014; 01/22/2014; 01/23/2014, and continuing day to day, Monday through Thursday, as needed at the discretion of the Administrative Law Judge.
