ORDER RE: REQUEST FOR  
RECONSIDERATION

On November 4, 2013, Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Elsa H. Jones, of the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) convened a prehearing conference (PHC) in this matter, during which the ALJ granted the motion of Santa Monica-Malibu Unified School District (District) to continue the matter. On November 8, 2013, OAH issued a formal PHC Order continuing the matter.

On November 12, 2013, Student's attorney filed a letter addressed to the Presiding ALJ for the Van Nuys office of OAH. In the letter, Student's attorney sought clarification of OAH's "practice concerning discretionary authority in reviewing good cause." Because the letter concerned events and the ruling that occurred at the PHC, OAH treated the letter as a request for reconsideration of the PHC Order, and so advised the parties.

On November 14, 2013, the District notified OAH that the parties had reached a settlement agreement, which provides for the matter to be dismissed upon school board approval. Consequently, the Motion for Reconsideration is moot.
