SUPPLMENTAL ORDER
FOLLOWING PRE-HEARING
CONFERENCE AUTHORIZING
ADDITIONAL WITNESSES

The prehearing conference in this matter was held on May 12, 2014, at which time the parties were ordered to meet and confer on the schedule of witnesses no later than May 16, 2014. On May 16, 2014, Student filed an amended witness list. On May 19, 2014, District filed an amended witness list, accompanied by a motion and a declaration to support the exchange of witnesses after the prehearing conference..

The parties may call the additional witnesses identified in their amended witness lists, but in no event shall the length of the hearing be extended beyond the time the parties committed to completing witness testimony at the May12, 2014, prehearing conference. The parties shall exchange expert witness resumes no later than noon, May 23, 2014, and shall include expert witness resumes in their exhibit books to avoid the unnecessary consumption of witness testimony time establishing expert qualifications.

As set forth in the prehearing conference order of May 15, 2014, the parties shall provide the ALJ at the start of the hearing with a witness list, including a schedule of witnesses, and the anticipated time for each witness.

This supplemental prehearing conference order is in addition to the prehearing conference order of May 15, 2014, which remains in full force and effect.

Failure to comply with this supplemental prehearing conference order may result in the exclusion of evidence or other sanctions.
