ORDER FOLLOWING PRE-HEARING
CONFERENCE, GRANTING MOTION
TO CONTINUE AND SETTING NEW
DATES

On April 18, 2014, a telephonic prehearing conference (PHC) was held before Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Robert Helfand, Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH), Dean T. Adams, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of the Fallbrook Union Elementary District (District). Student's mother appeared on behalf of Parent on behalf of Student (Student). The District filed its PHC Statement on April 15, 2014. Student has not filed a PHC Statement. The PHC was recorded.

Based on discussion of the parties, the ALJ issues the following order:

Motion to Continue: On April 16, 2014, Student filed with OAH a motion to continue on grounds that he was in the process of hiring an attorney. Student requested the hearing be continued to May 20, 2014. Student neglected to serve the District counsel with the motion. At the PHC, Student orally moved to continue the hearing on grounds that he is attempting to retain counsel and that Mother has recently suffered a mild stroke. The District did not oppose the motion but indicated that the proposed hearing date was not convenient due to a scheduling conflict and summer recess. The parties mutually agreed to continue the hearing to August 12-13, 2014. Good cause showing, the motion to continue is granted.

Accordingly, the currently scheduled hearing dates are vacated. This matter will be set as follows:

Prehearing Conference:	August 4, 2014, at 1:00 p.m.
Due Process Hearing:	August 12-13, 2014, starting at 9:30 a.m. on August 12, and continuing day to day, Monday through Thursday, as needed at the discretion of the Administrative Law Judge.
