NOTICE OF NO ACTION TAKEN

On April 30, 2014, Student filed a seven page document with the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). This document contains several pages of handwritten comments and statements. There are statements regarding the hearing date; submitting the case “on its face,” closing statements being contained within the shared evidence binder, resting Student’s case but reserving all rights, an opening statement and what appears to be an itemization of proposed resolutions for the upcoming hearing. There is no proof of service attached and no indication that the document was served on Sacramento City Unified School District.

No action will be taken by OAH in regards to the April 30, 2014 document. Student is advised to send separate, clearly written motions for each item she would like addressed. For instance, if Student is seeking to move the hearing date currently scheduled, she should send a motion asking for this and stating the reason for the request. If Student wants to add proposed remedies, Student can do this in her prehearing conference statement. Student is ordered to serve the document filed with OAH on April 30, 2014, on the attorney for the Sacramento City Unified School District.
