ORDER FOR SUPPLEMENTAL
BRIEFING ON MOTION FOR STAY
PUT

On May 5, 2014, Student filed a motion for stay put, asserting that Elk Grove Unified School District is refusing to implement Student's last agreed upon and implemented educational program developed by Student's prior school district, Sacramento City Unified School District. On May 8, 2014, Elk Grove filed an opposition to the motion, asserting that the motion is premature as Parents have not permitted Elk Grove to develop and offer a comparable educational program. Additional information is required before a ruling may be made on the pleadings.

ORDER

Within five days of this order, each party shall provide the following information and briefing regarding:

1. Did Student move out of the boundaries of Sacramento prior to April 25, 2014?
2. If Student did move out of the boundaries of the Sacramento prior to April 25, 2014, what effect did this have, if any, on whether the April 25, 2014 IEP is Student's last agreed upon and implemented educational program?

Each party shall include sworn declarations supporting any factual assertions included in its briefing.
