ORDER FOLLOWING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE, GRANTING JOINT
MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE AND
SETTING NEW DATES

On October 10, 2014, a telephonic prehearing conference was held before Administrative Law Judge Robert Helfand, Office of Administrative Hearings. David M. Grey, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of Parent on behalf of Student. Diane M. Willis, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of the Los Angeles Unified School District. The PHC was recorded.

Based on discussion of the parties, the ALJ issues the following order:

Motion to Continue: At the PHC, the parties jointly orally moved to continue the matter to November 4, 2014. The parties cited that counsel for LAUSD had only been retained within the past two days and was not familiar with the case, plus the parties are engaged in settlement negotiations. Good cause showing, the motion to continue is granted.

Accordingly, the currently scheduled hearing dates are vacated. This matter will be set as follows:

Prehearing Conference:	October 27, 2014, at 1:00 p.m.
Due Process Hearing:	November 4, 5, 10, and 11, 2014, starting at 9:30 a.m. on the first day, and continuing day to day, Monday through Thursday, as needed at the discretion of the Administrative Law Judge.
