On September 17, 2014, the Office of Administrative Hearings granted a continuance of the due process hearing in this matter to October 21, 2014, over Lincoln Unified School District’s objection. On September 18, 2014, OAH filed a routine Scheduling Order confirming October 21, 2014, as the continued date for the hearing. On September 25, 2014, Lincoln filed a motion to “clarify” the scheduling order “with information regarding the events of September 17, 2014 . . .” No response was received from Student.

Lincoln’s motion is in substance a request for more information about the disputed continuance. The reasons for the continuance were stated on the record by the Administrative Law Judge at the hearing, and Lincoln’s objections were stated on the record as well. The record adequately sets forth the events of September 17, 2014. Lincoln’s motion, which recounts those events in detail, shows that Lincoln is already adequately informed concerning the continuance. In any event, a routine scheduling order is inappropriate for the explanations Lincoln seeks. Lincoln’s ongoing objection to the continuance is noted.
