ORDER RESCHEDULING
PREHEARING CONFERENCE TO
3:00 PM ON JANUARY 23, 2015

On January 13, 2015, Student filed a motion to reschedule the prehearing conference to January 22, 2015 or February 2, 2015 on the ground that Student's attorney had a mandatory settlement conference on January 23, 2015 at 9:00 a.m. District did not oppose holding the prehearing conference on February 2, 2015.

OAH does not conduct prehearing conferences on Thursdays, as requested for January 22, 2015, and OAH is closed for training mandated by the California Department of Education the entire week of January 26-30, 2015. Given the age of this matter, the hearing will not be continued. Student's attorney notes in the motion that there is a possible dispute about the need for subpoenas for District personnel, such that holding the prehearing conference the day before the hearing is not practical. Absent such a dispute, OAH would consider holding the prehearing conference the day before the hearing.

Accordingly, the motion is denied. However, to attempt to accommodate Student's counsel, the prehearing conference will be delayed until 3:00 p.m. on January 23, 2015.
