ORDER FOLLOWING PREHEARING  
CONFERENCE AND ORDER TO  
SHOW CAUSE RE DISMISSAL

On March 2, 2015, a telephonic prehearing conference was held before Administrative Law Judge Susan Ruff, Office of Administrative Hearings. Christopher Fernandes, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of the Corona-Norco Unified School District. There was no appearance by or on behalf of Student or Student's parents. Student did not file a prehearing conference statement prior to the PHC. The PHC was recorded.

Based on discussion during the PHC, the ALJ issues the following order:

1. Prehearing Conference. The telephonic PHC is continued to Friday, March 6, 2015, at 3:00 p.m.
2. Order to Show Cause. Student is ordered to show cause at the telephonic PHC on March 6, 2015, at 3:00 p.m., as to why this matter should not be dismissed for failure to participate, prosecute, or advance the matter. Should Student provide adequate justification on the order to show cause, the PHC will proceed at that time. Student is further ordered to file a prehearing conference statement by noon on Wednesday, March 4, 2015, if Student intends to proceed to hearing.
3. Continuance Denied. District's request for continuance of the hearing is denied without prejudice. District may meet and confer with Student about dates and submit a new continuance request in writing prior to the telephonic PHC.
