ORDER FOLLOWING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE, SETTING ORDER TO
SHOW CAUSE RE DISMISSAL AND
DENYING DISTRICT'S MOTION TO
CONSOLIDATE, WITHOUT
PREJUDICE

On November 24, 2014, a telephonic prehearing conference (PHC) was held before Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Alexa J. Hohensee, Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). Angela Gordon, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of Lancaster School District. Parent did not pick up the call, and the ALJ left a voicemail message that a written order would be mailed regarding the PHC.

Parent has contacted OAH on multiple occasions to inform OAH that she wishes to withdraw this matter. On November 24, 2014, Parent notified OAH that she mailed a written request for dismissal earlier that day, but had no access to a fax machine for fax filing. In light of the representations of Parent to OAH:

1. Order to Show Cause re Dismissal. A telephonic status conference will be held on December 15, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. for Parent to show cause why this matter should not be dismissed. If Parent's request to withdraw or dismiss this matter is received prior to December 15, 2014, all dates will be vacated and the teleconference will not be held.

2. Continuance of Hearing Date and PHC. Until and unless this matter is withdrawn or dismissed at Parent's written request, or at the OSC, the hearing is continued and shall take place on February 24, 2015, at 9:30 a.m., and continuing day to day, Monday through Thursday as needed at the discretion of the ALJ. The PHC is continued to 10:00 a.m. on February 9, 2015.

3. Motion to Consolidate. District has a motion pending to consolidate this matter with another due process hearing matter. In light of Parents' notification to OAH that a request for dismissal is in route to be filed, District's motion to consolidate is denied without prejudice.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
