ORDER REGARDING
REPLACEMENT COPY OF
DISTRICT'S EXHIBIT 23

On October 30, 2014, District's Exhibit 23, a prior written notice dated September 2, 2014, was admitted into evidence. At the conclusion of the due process hearing later that day, the Administrative Law Judge returned to District's attorney District's pre-marked exhibits that had not been admitted into evidence. The ALJ mistakenly returned District's Exhibit 23 to District.

By 5:00 p.m. on November 6, 2014, concurrent with submission of its written closing argument, District shall file with OAH and serve upon Mother a true and correct copy of what had been marked and received as District's Exhibit 23. Student's Mother should compare it to the copy of District's Exhibit 23 she was provided at hearing. Student's Mother has until 5:00 p.m. on November 14, 2014, to file an objection to District's Exhibit 23 based solely on it not matching the copy she was provided at hearing. If Mother files an objection on the ground the exhibit does not match what she was provided at hearing, Mother shall include the copy of District's Exhibit 23 that she was provided for comparison.
