ORDER FOLLOWING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE AND GRANTING
MOTION TO CONTINUE PHC

On October 24, 2014, a telephonic prehearing conference was held before Administrative Law Judge Robert Helfand, Office of Administrative Hearings. S. Daniel Harbottle, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of the Newport-Mesa Unified School District. Phillip W. VanAllsburg, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of Parents on behalf of Student. The PHC was recorded.

Based on discussion of the parties, the ALJ issues the following order:

Motion to Continue: The parties jointly moved to continue the PHC until Monday, October 27, 2014, at 1:00 p.m., on grounds that Student had filed a motion to consolidate the instant matter with a newly filed case by Student, which was being processed by OAH. The Student filed similar and related issues as the instant matter. For the newly filed case to be processed and the motion to consolidate to be ruled on, good cause has been demonstrated.

Accordingly, the motion is granted and the PHC will be continued to Monday, October 27, 2014, at 3:00 p.m.
