ORDER FOLLOWING PREHEARING
CONFERENCE VACATING DATES
AND DISMISSING CASE

On October 20, 2014, a telephonic prehearing conference was held before Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Deidre L. Johnson, Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). Gail S. Hodes, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of Student. Nancy L. Klein, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of the Fort Bragg Unified School District. The PHC was recorded.

The PHC began at 11:00 a.m., and was continued to 1:00 p.m. on the same date to permit the parties to finalize their settlement negotiations and execute a written settlement. Fort Bragg and Student settled this case with a fully executed settlement agreement. Fort Bragg therefore requested on the record to withdraw its complaint with prejudice, and later on the same date filed a written request to dismiss the case.

This case having been settled, all dates are vacated and the case is dismissed with prejudice.
