ORDER REQUESTING ADDITIONAL
INFORMATION REGARDING
PANAMA-BUENA VISTA'S REQUEST
FOR SANCTIONS

On November 4, 2014, attorney Stacey Inman, counsel for Panama-Buena Vista Union School District (Panama-Buena Vista), filed a motion for sanctions against Student's attorney, Nicole Hodge Amey. Ms. Inman included a declaration under penalty of perjury that specified only the total amount of fees charged but did not include an itemized billing statement justifying the amount of sanctions requested.

Therefore, Panama-Buena Vista is ordered to file and serve an itemized billing statement for the time period of October 6, 2014 through November 4, 2014, including dates, description of work, hourly rate, and who performed the work, with a declaration authenticating the billing statement with appropriate facts. Panama-Buena Vista may redact any attorney-client privileged information from the billing statement. Panama-Buena Vista shall file and serve the itemized statement and supporting declaration no later than 3:00 p.m. on December 3, 2014. Ms. Amey may file and serve a response to the itemized statement no later than noon on Friday, December 5, 2014.
