ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE WHY THIS
MATTER SHOULD NOT BE
DISMISSED

On November 21, 2104, at 3:00 p.m., a telephonic prehearing conference was scheduled in this matter. Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) June Lehrman of the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) telephoned both parties. There was no appearance by Student despite messages left on parent's voice mail. Shari Robertson and Diana Massaria, appeared on behalf of the Los Angeles Unified School District.

BOTH PARTIES ARE HEREBY ORDERED to appear telephonically on Monday, December 1, at 1:00 p.m. to show cause, if any, as to why the above-entitled case should not be dismissed. OAH will initiate the telephone call.

District orally moved to continue the hearing in this matter, currently set for December 2, 2014. The motion is denied without prejudice. Should the matter not be dismissed at the December 1, 2014 telephonic appearance, District is given leave to re-state their motion to continue, which will be addressed at that time.
