ORDER RE CONTINUANCE OF  
HEARING FOR SUBMISSION OF  
WRITTEN CLOSING ARGUMENTS

Hearing of this matter commenced on May 19, 2015 in San Diego, California and testimony concluded on May 20, 2015. Tiffany Santos, Attorney at Law, represented Vista Unified School District. Dawn Dully, District's Executive Director of Special Education, attended both days of hearing on behalf of District. Student was represented at the hearing by his Mother and Father. Parents were present at the commencement of the hearing but left after finishing their opening statement on behalf of Student on the morning of May 19, 2015, and did not return for any part of the hearing thereafter.

At the conclusion of testimony on May 20, 2015, the ALJ granted two weeks to prepare and submit written closing arguments.

ORDER

1. The matter is continued from May 20, 2015, until June 3, 2015, to allow both parties to prepare and submit written closing arguments, if they wish to do so.
2. Written closing arguments shall be no more than 20 pages long, and must be submitted on or before 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 3, 2015.
