APPLICABLE LAW

If at the time of a scheduled prehearing conference, an ALJ has been assigned to the hearing, any challenge to the assigned ALJ shall be made no later than commencement of that prehearing conference. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1034, subd. (c).)

DISCUSSION AND ORDER

Because ALJ Krikorian has already presided over a prehearing conference in this matter on October 19, 2015, the peremptory challenge is not timely. District's peremptory challenge is therefore denied
