ORDER GRANTING STUDENT'S
REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO RESPOND TO MOTIONS TO
DISMISS

On September 24, 2015, Student filed a request for an extension of time until Wednesday, September 30, 2015, to file his responses to Loleta Union School District's motion to dismiss issues outside the statute of limitations and Humboldt Del-Norte Special Education Local Plan Area's motion to be dismissed as a party. Student's responses to both motions are presently due by the close of business on September 25, 2015. Student requests the additional time because his counsel was recently injured in a car accident.

On September 25, 2015, a representative from the office for counsel for Loleta Union and Humboldt Del-Norte informed the Office of Administrative Hearings that it would not be filing a response to Student's request.
