The Interagency Agreement (IA) between the California Department of Education (CDE) and the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) requires OAH to report on a quarterly basis certain information related to mediations and due process and expedited hearings, as well as information required to be maintained according to state and federal law.¹ The following report addresses those IA reporting requirements.

CASE FILINGS²

During the first quarter of fiscal year 2012-2013, OAH received 738 new case filings. For a comprehensive chart of the number of filings since 2005, please see Attachment A at page 21.

CASES BY FILING PARTY

Overall, there were 738 total cases filed this quarter, which consisted of 633 student-filed cases and 105 district-filed cases.³ Of the student-filed cases, five cases involved both expedited and non-expedited issues (dual hearings), and no cases that were exclusively expedited issues.⁴ Of the district-filed cases, there were no cases that involved expedited issues or dual hearings.⁵ Of the 738 cases filed, five requests by students and no requests by districts were for a due process hearing only. A detailed list of all student-filed cases this quarter broken down by district appears in Attachment B beginning on page 22.

Of the 738 cases opened by OAH this quarter, 733 requests were for mediation related to due process hearing or mediation-only this quarter.⁶ Of the 733 requests for mediation, 52 were requests for mediation-only.⁷ The remaining 681 requests for mediation were related to due process hearing requests.⁸ Of the total requests for mediation, five student-filed cases and no district-filed cases involved dual hearings.⁹



LEGAL REPRESENTATION

During the first quarter, 738 cases were filed, which consisted of 633 student-filed requests and 105 district-filed requests. Of the 633 cases filed by students requesting due process, 521 cases (82 percent) were filed by attorneys; of the 105 district-filed cases, 89 cases (85 percent) were filed by attorneys.¹⁰ Of the 738 cases filed this quarter, 610 cases (83 percent) were filed by attorneys. This fiscal year, 82 percent of student cases and 85 percent of district cases were filed with legal representation.



GRADE LEVEL

The majority of the 738 cases filed this quarter originated from students in the primary grades (370 cases), followed by those in high school (193 cases), junior high school (92 cases) and preschool (73 cases). The grade level of the student was not specified in 10 of the case filings.¹¹



ISSUES AND REMEDIES

Cases filed this quarter involved a variety of issues and requested remedies. The number of issues raised varied per case, with some cases raising only one issue, and others raising several issues. The most common issues raised in the 738 cases filed this quarter were placement (402 cases) and designated instruction and services (394 cases). Other issues included: assessment (316 cases), speech and language services (252 cases), occupational therapy services (199 cases), one-to-one aide services (141 cases), goals and objectives (90 cases), procedural violations (81 cases), extended school year services (66 cases), eligibility (65 cases), private services (44 cases), and mental health services (35 cases). Compensatory education was requested as a remedy in 323 cases and reimbursement was requested as a remedy in 279 cases.¹²


ELIGIBILITY CATEGORY ¹³

The majority of cases filed this quarter involved students identified under the eligibility category of Autistic-Like Behaviors (258 cases). Other identified areas of eligibility included: Specific Learning Disability (117 cases), Other Health Impaired (116 cases), Speech or Language Impairment (101 cases), Emotional Disturbance (54 cases), Intellectual Disability (25 cases), Orthopedic Impairment (25 cases), Visual Impairment (13 cases), Hearing Impairment (10 cases), Deafness (seven cases), Traumatic Brain Injury (two cases), and Deaf/Blind (one case). The student’s area of eligibility was not identified in 150 cases.¹⁴




CLOSED CASES

During this quarter, 795 cases were closed. Currently, 643 cases remain pending.¹⁵ Of the 643 cases pending, 616 are related to due process hearing requests and 27 are related to mediation-only requests. Of the 795 cases closed, 743 were related to due process hearing requests and 52 were related to mediation-only requests. Of the 795 cases closed, 772 (97 percent) were resolved in some manner without need for a due process hearing.¹⁶ For the fiscal year to date, 97 percent of cases have resolved without need for a due process hearing.



The majority of cases closed this quarter were settled during mediation (332 cases), followed by those that resolved outside the mediation or resolution session process (274 cases), and those cases withdrawn by the filing party without explanation (124 cases). Additionally this quarter, 20 cases resolved during the resolution session¹⁷, 10 mediation-only cases were not settled at mediation, six mediation-only cases were closed due to a party declining participation¹⁸, four cases were dismissed by a motion to dismiss, one case was dismissed after failing to amend following a notice of insufficiency, and one case was closed for other reasons. Out of the 795 cases closed this quarter, 23 were closed following a hearing and decision on the merits.






MEDIATIONS

This quarter, 516 mediations were held. The mediations were held in cases opened this quarter and in cases that were pending from prior quarters. Of the 516 mediations held this quarter, in 29 cases an additional mediation session was scheduled. Of the 516 mediations held, 479 were related to due process hearing requests, no cases involved only expedited issues, one case was related to a dual hearing request, and 36 were related to mediation-only requests.

For mediation requests related to due process hearing, 305 cases reached an agreement at mediation,¹⁹ and 26 mediation-only cases reached an agreement,²⁰ for a total of 331 cases resulting in an agreement.²¹ Since no cases involving only expedited issues went to mediation, there were none that reached an agreement. In the one dual case, which involved both expedited and non-expedited issues, which went to mediation, an interim agreement was reached.²²

Out of the 516 mediations held this quarter, mediation was successful in 331 cases (64 percent), with 185 mediations resulting in impasse. At the end of this quarter, 284 cases have mediations pending²³ and 407 cases have hearings pending.²⁴




For the 2012-2013 fiscal year, OAH has conducted 516 mediations, with 331 resulting in an agreement and 185 resulting in impasse. The overall mediation success rate for fiscal year 2012-2013 is 64 percent. For the 2012-2013 fiscal year, 97 percent of cases have resolved without need for a due process hearing decision.



DUE PROCESS HEARINGS

During the first quarter, out of the 795 cases closed, 23 final decisions were issued. Of the 23 decisions issued, two decisions were issued within the 45-day timeline, 20 were issued within the 45-day timeline plus extension, and one decision was issued late.²⁵ There were no decisions issued in a case with expedited issues and no changes of placement were ordered for this quarter.²⁶ Overall, this quarter, 96 percent of decisions were issued within the requisite timeline. For the 2012-2013 fiscal year, OAH has issued 23 decisions and 96 percent have been issued within the requisite timelines.

Based upon the issues for hearing identified by the parties, students prevailed on all issues in two hearings (nine percent) and districts prevailed on all issues in 17 hearings (74 percent). In four of the 23 decisions issued (17 percent), the issues in the decision were split between student and district, with students prevailing on five issues and districts prevailing on 18 issues.²⁷ For the current fiscal year, students have prevailed on all issues in two hearings (nine percent), districts have prevailed on all issues in 17 hearings (74 percent), and four cases (17 percent)



resulted in a split decision of the issues. Copies of all decisions have been provided to CDE and have been posted on the OAH website.

Of the 23 decisions issued this quarter, two cases involved preschool students, eight cases involved elementary school students, one case involved middle school students, and 12 cases involved high school students.

On average, the due process hearings lasted four days, with students using 44 percent of the hearing time to present their cases and districts using 55 percent of hearing time for case presentation.²⁸ During case presentation, students called an average of five witnesses per case and the districts called an average of six witnesses per case.²⁹

The hearings involved multiple areas of disability. The cases involved students identified with a disability area of Autistic-Like Behaviors (10 cases), Emotional Disturbance (four cases), Other Health Impaired (three cases), Intellectual Disability (two cases), Specific Learning Disability (two cases), Multiple Disabilities (one case), and in one case the student was found not eligible.

RESOLUTION SESSIONS

The IDEA requires school districts to hold resolution sessions within 15 days of receipt of a student’s complaint. While there is no legal requirement to report this data to OAH, CDE requests that OAH track this information. Accordingly, OAH sends letters to school districts requesting them to report for each case if a resolution session was held, the outcome of each session, and other information about each session. This quarter, based on the information OAH received, 104 resolution sessions were reported as held and 202 were reported as not held. Of the 104 resolution sessions reported as held, there were no sessions regarding an expedited case or cases involving both expedited and non-expedited issues.³⁰ Attachment C, beginning on page 42, reports all resolution session information reported to OAH and Attachment D beginning on page 59 details the matters from the first quarter that OAH has not received any resolution session data.

MOTIONS

Prehearing motions and Notices of Insufficiency (NOIs) comprise a substantial amount of the work completed by administrative law judges. For this quarter, 491 prehearing motions and 31 NOIs were filed by the parties and ruled upon by OAH. Of the 491 prehearing motions that were ruled on by OAH, 75 were filed by students, 85 were filed by districts or other local education agencies and 331 motions were stipulated.³¹ Of the 31 NOIs filed, 17 of the complaints were found sufficient, 13 were found insufficient, and one was found partially sufficient. One case was dismissed for insufficiency after failing to amend the complaint.³²


There were 491 prehearing motions filed this quarter. Of the 75 motions filed by students, 49 were granted, four were granted in part, and 22 were denied. Of the 85 motions filed by districts or other local education agencies, 52 were granted, 21 were denied, nine were granted in part, and three were deemed moot. Of the 331 stipulated motions, 319 were granted, three were granted in part, and nine were denied.³³ The prehearing motions involved a variety of issues, with the largest number involving motions to continue (357 motions).

NON-ENGLISH-SPEAKING STUDENTS AND INTERPRETERS

During this quarter, 93 non-English-speaking students were identified through the due process hearing request forms.³⁴ Of the 93 non-English-speaking students, 82 students spoke Spanish, four students spoke Korean, two students spoke Mandarin, one student spoke Arabic, one student spoke Farsi, one student spoke Japanese, one student spoke Portugese, and one student spoke Vietnamese. OAH received 100 requests for the assistance of an interpreter at a hearing or mediation³⁵.

STUDENTS OF COLOR

CDE has requested that OAH collect data on the number of students of color accessing the system. To facilitate this request, OAH’s due process hearing request form asks the parties to voluntarily provide this information. However, not all hearing requests are made using the OAH form. This quarter, 13 students reported as being a student of color and nine students reported as not being a student of color.³⁶ The remaining students did not state whether they were a student of color.



TRANSCRIPT REQUESTS AND APPEALS

Data on the number of appeals to state and federal courts and appellate outcomes are collected on an ongoing basis and include all cases that OAH was notified were appealed since July 2005. This quarter, OAH received 31 requests for transcripts, and was notified of four new appeals filed. Of the appeals reported in previous quarters, one OAH decision was upheld, one was withdrawn, one dismissed, one appeal resulted in settlement, and three appeals were further appealed to a higher court.³⁷

Based on correspondence with the parties and filings that have been provided to OAH, 214 cases have been appealed since July 2005³⁸. Of the 214 cases that have been appealed, 51 have settled, 44 have been dismissed, 42 were upheld, four were remanded, seven were reversed, and six were withdrawn. There are 18 cases that are currently on appeal. Of the cases that have been appealed, 42 have gone on to further appeal to a higher court.

A detailed list of cases that have been further appealed to a higher court can be found in Attachment F at page 78. Due to the difficulty in identifying which cases are appealed and the appellate outcomes, parties are invited to notify OAH of any case on appeal or any outcome on appeal that is not included in Attachment E or Attachment F.

MEDIATION AND HEARING EVALUATIONS

OAH is required to send evaluations to all parties attending mediations and hearings. The evaluations contain a rating scale of 1 to 5, with 1 being poor/very dissatisfied and 5 being excellent/extremely satisfied. The evaluations ask the parties to evaluate the mediation, the administrative law judge and OAH in general.

This quarter, 79 mediation evaluations were completed. Evaluations were completed by parents (18 cases), legal counsel for parents (11 cases), advocates for parents (six cases), school district representatives (34 cases), and legal counsel for districts (five cases). In five cases, the evaluator did not indicate his or her role in the mediation.
