The Interagency Agreement (IA) between the California Department of Education (CDE) and the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) requires OAH to report on a quarterly basis certain information related to mediations and due process and expedited hearings, as well as information required to be maintained according to state and federal law.<sup>1</sup> The following report addresses those IA reporting requirements.

### CASE FILINGS<sup>2</sup>

During the first quarter of fiscal year 2013-2014, OAH received 911 new case filings. For a comprehensive chart of the number of filings since 2005, please see Attachment A at page 21.

### CASES BY FILING PARTY

Overall, there were 911 total cases filed this quarter, which consisted of 789 student-filed cases and 122 district-filed cases.<sup>3</sup> Of the student-filed cases, 12 cases involved both expedited and non-expedited issues (dual hearings), and two cases that were exclusively expedited issues.<sup>4</sup> Of the district-filed cases, there was one case that involved expedited issues and one case that involved a dual hearing.<sup>5</sup> Of the 911 cases filed, four requests by a student and one request by a district were for a due process hearing only. A detailed list of all student-filed cases this quarter broken down by district appears in Attachment B beginning on page 22.

Of the 911 cases opened by OAH this quarter, 906 had requests for mediation related to due process hearing or mediation-only.<sup>6</sup> Of the 906 requests for mediation, 60 were requests for mediation-only.<sup>7</sup> The remaining 846 requests for mediation were related to due process hearing requests.<sup>8</sup> Of the total requests for mediation, two student-filed cases and one district-filed case involved expedited issues only, and 12 student-filed cases and one district-filed case involved dual hearings.<sup>9</sup>



### LEGAL REPRESENTATION

During the first quarter, 911 cases were filed, which consisted of 789 student-filed requests and 122 district-filed requests. Of the 789 cases filed by students requesting due process, 676 cases (86 percent) were filed by attorneys; of the 122 district-filed cases, 90 cases (74 percent) were filed by attorneys.<sup>10</sup> Of the 911 cases filed this quarter, 766 cases (84 percent) were filed by attorneys. This fiscal year, 86 percent of student cases and 74 percent of district cases were filed with legal representation.



**GRADE LEVEL**

The majority of the 911 cases filed this quarter originated from students in the primary grades (473 cases), followed by those in high school (208 cases), junior high school (143 cases) and preschool (75 cases). The grade level of the student was not specified in 12 of the case filings.<sup>11</sup>


### ISSUES AND REMEDIES

Cases filed this quarter involved a variety of issues and requested remedies. The number of issues raised varied per case, with some cases raising only one issue, and others raising several issues. The most common issues raised in the 911 cases filed this quarter were placement (572 cases) and designated instruction and services (553 cases). Other issues included: assessment (474 cases), speech and language services (311 cases), occupational therapy services (219 cases), one-to-one aide services (214 cases), goals and objectives (157 cases), procedural violations (134 cases), eligibility (98 cases), extended school year services (82 cases), ABA services (72 cases), mental health services (59 cases), private services (57 cases), and discipline (23 cases). Compensatory education was requested as a remedy in 414 cases and reimbursement was requested as a remedy in 331 cases.<sup>12</sup>


### ELIGIBILITY CATEGORY <sup>13</sup>

The majority of cases filed this quarter involved students identified under the eligibility category of Autistic-Like Behaviors (316 cases). Other identified areas of eligibility included: Other Health Impaired (163 cases), Specific Learning Disability (162 cases), Speech or Language Impairment (129 cases), Emotional Disturbance (72 cases), Intellectual Disability (38 cases), Multiple Disabilities (19 cases), Orthopedic Impairment (12 cases), Deafness (12 cases), Hearing Impairment (12 cases), Visual Impairment (10 cases), Deaf/Blind (three cases), and Traumatic Brain Injury (two cases). The student’s area of eligibility was not identified in 193 cases.<sup>14</sup>



### CLOSED CASES

During this quarter, 845 cases were closed. Currently, 724 cases remain pending, of which there are six student-filed and no district-filed requests that involve dual hearings and one district-filed request that involves expedited issues only.<sup>15</sup> Of the 724 cases pending, 687 are related to due process hearing requests and 37 are related to mediation-only requests. Of the 845 cases closed, 794 were related to due process hearing requests and 51 were related to mediation-only requests. Of the 845 cases closed, 826 (98 percent) were resolved in some manner without need for a due process hearing.<sup>16</sup> For the fiscal year to date, 98 percent of cases have resolved without need for a due process hearing.



The majority of cases closed this quarter were settled during mediation (360 cases), followed by those that were resolved outside the mediation or resolution session process (303 cases), and those cases withdrawn by the filing party without explanation (110 cases). Additionally this quarter, 20 cases resolved during the resolution session,<sup>17</sup> 16 mediation-only cases were not settled at mediation, 12 cases were dismissed by a motion to dismiss, two cases were dismissed after failing to amend following a notice of insufficiency, two mediation-only cases were closed due to a party declining participation, one case was closed for other reasons, and no cases closed at a settlement conference or due to inactivity. Out of the 845 cases closed this quarter, 19 were closed following a hearing and decision on the merits.



## MEDIATIONS

This quarter, 577 mediations were held. The mediations were held in cases opened this quarter and in cases that were pending from prior quarters. Of the 577 mediations held this quarter, in 114 cases an additional mediation session was scheduled. Of the 577 mediations held, 529 were related to due process hearing requests and 48 were related to mediation-only requests. Of the 529 mediations held related to due process hearing requests, there were three cases that involved only expedited issues and 13 cases were related to a dual hearing request.

Of the mediation requests related to due process hearings, 353 cases reached an agreement at mediation,<sup>18</sup> and 27 mediation-only cases reached an agreement,<sup>19</sup> for a total of 380 cases resulting in an agreement.<sup>20</sup> Of the three cases involving expedited issues only that requested mediation, one of the cases reached an agreement at mediation. Of the 13 dual cases, which involved both expedited and non-expedited issues that went to mediation, seven reached an agreement.<sup>21</sup>

Out of the 577 mediations held this quarter, mediation was successful in 380 cases (66 percent), with 197 mediations resulting in impasse. At the end of this quarter, 331 cases have mediations pending,<sup>22</sup> and 687 cases have hearings pending.<sup>23</sup>

For the 2013-2014 fiscal year, OAH has conducted 577 mediations, with 380 resulting in an agreement and 197 resulting in impasse. The overall mediation success rate for fiscal year 2013-2014 is 66 percent. For the 2013-2014 fiscal year, 98 percent of cases have resolved without need for a due process hearing decision.



### DUE PROCESS HEARINGS

During the first quarter, out of the 845 cases closed, 19 final decisions were issued. Of the 19 decisions issued, all 19 were issued within the 45-day timeline plus extensions, and no decision was issued late.<sup>24</sup> There were no decisions issued in a case with expedited issues and no



changes of placement were ordered for this quarter.<sup>25</sup> Overall, this quarter, 100 percent of decisions were issued within the requisite timeline. For the 2013-2014 fiscal year, OAH has issued 19 decisions and 100 percent have been issued within the requisite timelines.

Based upon the issues for hearing identified by the parties, during this quarter districts prevailed on all issues in seven hearings (37 percent) and students prevailed on all issues in five hearings (26 percent). In seven of the 19 decisions issued (37 percent), the issues in the decision were split between student and district, with students prevailing on 20 issues and districts prevailing on 38 issues.<sup>26</sup> For the current fiscal year, students have prevailed on all issues in five hearings (26 percent), districts have prevailed on all issues in seven hearings (37 percent), and seven cases (37 percent) resulted in a split decision of the issues. Copies of all decisions have been provided to CDE and have been posted on the OAH website.

On average, the due process hearings lasted three days, with students using 48 percent of the hearing time to present their cases and districts using 51 percent of the hearing time for case presentation.<sup>27</sup> During case presentation, both students and districts called an average of six witnesses per case.<sup>28</sup>

The hearings involved multiple areas of disability. The cases involved students identified with a disability area of Autistic-Like Behaviors (10 cases), Emotional Disturbance (two cases), Other Health Impairments (two cases), Intellectual Disability (one case), Multiple Disabilities (one case), Specific Learning Disabilities (one case), Speech or Language Impairments (one case) and in one case the student was found not eligible.

### RESOLUTION SESSIONS

The IDEA requires school districts to hold resolution sessions within 15 days of receipt of a student’s complaint. While there is no legal requirement to report this data to OAH, CDE requests that OAH track this information. Accordingly, OAH sends letters to school districts requesting them to report for each case if a resolution session was held, the outcome of each session, and other information about each session. This quarter, based on the information OAH received, 108 resolution sessions were reported as held and 164 were reported as not held. Of the 108 resolution sessions reported as held, two cases involved both expedited and non-expedited issues, and no session was held regarding an expedited case.<sup>29</sup> Of the cases reported as held, 38 were reported as reaching a signed settlement agreement at the resolution sessions. Attachment C, beginning on page 46, reports all resolution session information reported to OAH this quarter and Attachment D, beginning on page 67, details the cases from this quarter for which OAH has not received any resolution session data.

### MOTIONS

Prehearing motions and Notices of Insufficiency (NOIs) comprise a substantial amount of the work completed by administrative law judges. For this quarter, 435 prehearing motions and 40 NOIs were filed by the parties and ruled upon by OAH. Of the 435 prehearing motions that were ruled on by OAH, 94 were filed by students, 78 were filed by districts or other local education agencies and 263 motions were stipulated.<sup>30</sup> Of the 40 NOIs filed, 19 of the complaints were found sufficient, 16 were found insufficient, and five were found partially sufficient. Two cases were dismissed for insufficiency after failing to amend the complaint.<sup>31</sup>

There were 435 prehearing motions filed this quarter. Of the 94 motions filed by students, 56 were granted, 34 were denied, and four were granted in part. Of the 78 motions filed by districts or other local education agencies, 45 were granted, 20 were denied, 10 were granted in part, and three were found moot. Of the 263 stipulated motions, 252 were granted, eight were denied, and three were granted in part.<sup>32</sup> The prehearing motions involved a variety of issues, with the largest number involving motions to continue (301 motions).



### NON-ENGLISH-SPEAKING STUDENTS AND INTERPRETERS

During this quarter, 203 non-English-speaking students were identified through the due process hearing request forms.<sup>33</sup> Of the 203 non-English-speaking students, 183 students spoke Spanish, six spoke Vietnamese, four spoke Korean, two spoke Arabic, two spoke Farsi, two spoke Indonesian, two spoke Mandarin, and two spoke Portuguese.

### STUDENTS OF COLOR


CDE has requested that OAH collect data on the number of students of color accessing the system. To facilitate this request, OAH’s due process hearing request form asks the parties to voluntarily provide this information. However, not all hearing requests are made using the OAH form. This quarter, 15 students reported as being a student of color and 10 students reported as not being a student of color.<sup>35</sup> The remaining students did not state whether they were a student of color.

### TRANSCRIPT REQUESTS AND APPEALS

Data on the number of appeals to state and federal courts and appellate outcomes are collected on an ongoing basis and include all cases about which OAH was notified of an appeal since July 2005. This quarter, OAH received 26 requests for transcripts, and was notified of two new appeals filed. Of the appeals reported in previous quarters, one OAH decision was upheld, one decision was reversed, and one appeal was further appealed to a higher court.<sup>36</sup>

Based on correspondence with the parties and filings that have been provided to OAH, 223 cases have been appealed since July 2005. Of the 223 cases that have been appealed, 53 have settled, 51 were upheld, 49 have been dismissed, nine were reversed, six were withdrawn, and four were remanded. There are seven cases that are currently on appeal and 44 have gone on to further appeal to a higher court.

Due to the difficulty in identifying which cases are appealed and the appellate outcomes, parties are invited to notify OAH of any case on appeal or any outcome on appeal that is not listed in either Attachment E or Attachment F.

### **MEDIATION AND HEARING EVALUATIONS**

OAH is required to send evaluations to all parties attending mediations and hearings. The evaluations contain a rating scale of 1 to 5, with 1 being poor/very dissatisfied and 5 being excellent/extremely satisfied. The evaluations ask the parties to evaluate the mediation or hearing, the administrative law judge and OAH in general.

This quarter, 190 mediation evaluations were completed. Evaluations were completed by parents (43 evaluations), legal counsel for parents (32 evaluation), school district representatives (86 evaluations), legal counsel for districts (13 evaluations), and non-attorney advocates for parents (six evaluations). In 10 of the evaluations submitted, the evaluator did not indicate his or her role in the mediation.
