Quarterly Data Report
Second Quarter 2012 - 2013 Fiscal Year
October 1, 2012 - December 31, 2012**

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The Interagency Agreement (IA) between the California Department of Education (CDE) and the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) requires OAH to report on a quarterly basis certain information related to mediations and due process and expedited hearings, as well as information required to be maintained according to state and federal law.¹ The following report addresses those IA reporting requirements.

CASE FILINGS²

During the second quarter of fiscal year 2012-2013, OAH received 708 new case filings. For a comprehensive chart of the number of filings since 2005, please see Attachment A at page 21.

CASES BY FILING PARTY

Overall, there were 708 total cases filed this quarter, which consisted of 600 student-filed cases and 108 district-filed cases.³ Of the student-filed cases, 10 cases involved both expedited and non-expedited issues (dual hearings), and four cases that were exclusively expedited issues.⁴ Of the district-filed cases, there was one case that involved expedited issues and no cases that involved dual hearings.⁵ Of the 708 cases filed, five requests by students and no requests by districts were for a due process hearing only. A detailed list of all student-filed cases this quarter broken down by district appears in Attachment B beginning on page 22.

Of the 708 cases opened by OAH this quarter, 703 688 requests were for mediation related to due process hearing or mediation-only this quarter.⁶ Of the 703 requests for mediation, 46 were requests for mediation-only.⁷ The remaining 657 requests for mediation were related to due process hearing requests.⁸ Of the total requests for mediation, 10 student-filed cases and no district-filed cases involved dual hearings.⁹



LEGAL REPRESENTATION

During the second quarter, 708 cases were filed, which consisted of 600 student-filed requests and 108 district-filed requests. Of the 600 cases filed by students requesting due process, 486 cases (81 percent) were filed by attorneys; of the 108 district-filed cases, 87 cases (81 percent) were filed by attorneys.¹⁰ Of the 708 cases filed this quarter, 573 cases (81 percent) were filed by attorneys. This fiscal year, 82 percent of student cases and 83 percent of district cases were filed with legal representation.



GRADE LEVEL

The majority of the 708 cases filed this quarter originated from students in the primary grades (298 cases), followed by those in high school (206 cases), junior high school (111 cases) and preschool (80 cases). The grade level of the student was not specified in 13 of the case filings.¹¹



ISSUES AND REMEDIES

Cases filed this quarter involved a variety of issues and requested remedies. The number of issues raised varied per case, with some cases raising only one issue, and others raising several issues. The most common issues raised in the 708 cases filed this quarter were designated instruction and services (397 cases) and placement (360 cases). Other issues included: assessment (315 cases), speech and language services (196 cases), occupational therapy services (129 cases), one-to-one aide services (124 cases), goals and objectives (74 cases), procedural violations (69 cases), eligibility (53 cases), extended school year services (47 cases), private services (38 cases), mental health services (35 cases), and discipline (12 cases). Compensatory education was requested as a remedy in 297 cases and reimbursement was requested as a remedy in 247 cases.¹²


ELIGIBILITY CATEGORY ¹³

The majority of cases filed this quarter involved students identified under the eligibility category of Autistic-Like Behaviors (226 cases). Other identified areas of eligibility included: Other Health Impaired (131 cases), Speech or Language Impairment (98 cases), Specific Learning Disability (94 cases), Emotional Disturbance (53 cases), Orthopedic Impairment (28 cases), Intellectual Disability (17 cases), Visual Impairment (11 cases), Hearing Impairment (eight cases), Deafness (six cases), and Traumatic Brain Injury (five cases). The student's area of eligibility was not identified in 172 cases.¹⁴



CLOSED CASES

During this quarter, 698 cases were closed. Currently, 608 cases remain pending.¹⁵ Of the 601 cases pending, 586 are related to due process hearing requests and 15 are related to mediation-only requests. Of the 698 cases closed, 648 were related to due process hearing requests and 50 were related to mediation-only requests. Of the 698 cases closed, 664 (95 percent) were resolved in some manner without need for a due process hearing.¹⁶ For the fiscal year to date, 96 percent of cases have resolved without need for a due process hearing.



The majority of cases closed this quarter were resolved outside the mediation or resolution session process (265 cases), followed by those that settled during mediation (248 cases), and those cases withdrawn by the filing party without explanation (91 cases). Additionally this quarter, 23 cases resolved during the resolution session¹⁷, nine mediation-only cases were not settled at mediation, eight cases were dismissed after failing to amend following a notice of insufficiency, seven cases were dismissed by a motion to dismiss, five mediation-only cases were closed due to a party declining participation¹⁸, two cases were closed for other reasons, and one case closed at settlement conference. Out of the 698 cases closed this quarter, 34 were closed following a hearing and decision on the merits.






MEDIATIONS

This quarter, 384 mediations were held. The mediations were held in cases opened this quarter and in cases that were pending from prior quarters. Of the 384 mediations held this quarter, in 76 cases an additional mediation session was scheduled. Of the 384 mediations held, 348 were related to due process hearing requests, three cases involved only expedited issues, five cases were related to a dual hearing request, and 36 were related to mediation-only requests.

For mediation requests related to due process hearing, 226 cases reached an agreement at mediation,¹⁹ and 24 mediation-only cases reached an agreement,²⁰ for a total of 250 cases resulting in an agreement.²¹ Of the three cases involving only expedited issues that went to mediation, one reached an agreement. Of the five dual cases, which involved both expedited and non-expedited issues, which went to mediation, four reached an agreement.²²

Out of the 384 mediations held this quarter, mediation was successful in 250 cases (65 percent), with 134 mediations resulting in impasse. At the end of this quarter, 311 cases have mediations pending²³ and 586 cases have hearings pending.²⁴



For the 2012-2013 fiscal year, OAH has conducted 900 mediations, with 581 resulting in an agreement and 319 resulting in impasse. The overall mediation success rate for fiscal year



2012-2013 is 65 percent. For the 2012-2013 fiscal year, 96 percent of cases have resolved without need for a due process hearing decision.



DUE PROCESS HEARINGS

During the second quarter, out of the 698 cases closed, 34 final decisions were issued. Of the 34 decisions issued, three decisions were issued within the 45-day timeline, 31 were issued within the 45-day timeline plus extension, and no decisions were issued late.²⁵ There were no decisions issued in a case with expedited issues and no changes of placement were ordered for this quarter.²⁶ Overall, this quarter, 100 percent of decisions were issued within the requisite timeline. For the 2012-2013 fiscal year, OAH has issued 57 decisions and 98 percent have been issued within the requisite timelines.


Based upon the issues for hearing identified by the parties, students prevailed on all issues in two hearings (six percent) and districts prevailed on all issues in 19 hearings (56 percent). In 13 of the 34 decisions issued (38 percent), the issues in the decision were split between student and district, with students prevailing on 23 issues and districts prevailing on 79 issues.²⁷ For the current fiscal year, students have prevailed on all issues in four hearings (seven percent), districts have prevailed on all issues in 36 hearings (63 percent), and 17 cases (30 percent) resulted in a split decision of the issues. Copies of all decisions have been provided to CDE and have been posted on the OAH website.

Of the 34 decisions issued this quarter, one case involved preschool students, 16 cases involved elementary school students, two cases involved middle school students, and 15 cases involved high school students.

On average, the due process hearings lasted three days, with students using 51 percent of the hearing time to present their cases and districts using 48 percent of hearing time for case presentation.²⁸ During case presentation, students called an average of eight witnesses per case and the districts called an average of seven witnesses per case.²⁹

The hearings involved multiple areas of disability. The cases involved students identified with a disability area of Autistic-Like Behaviors (14 cases), Other Health Impaired (five cases), Intellectual Disability (five cases), Emotional Disturbance (two cases), Orthopedic Impairments (two cases), Specific Learning Disability (one case), Multiple Disabilities (one case), Hearing Impairment (one case), Speech or Language Impairments (one case), and in two cases the student was found not eligible.

RESOLUTION SESSIONS

The IDEA requires school districts to hold resolution sessions within 15 days of receipt of a student’s complaint. While there is no legal requirement to report this data to OAH, CDE requests that OAH track this information. Accordingly, OAH sends letters to school districts requesting them to report for each case if a resolution session was held, the outcome of each session, and other information about each session. This quarter, based on the information OAH received, 46 resolution sessions were reported as held and 153 were reported as not held. Of the 46 resolution sessions reported as held, there were no sessions regarding an expedited case or cases involving both expedited and non-expedited issues.³⁰ Attachment C, beginning on page 41, reports all resolution session information reported to OAH this quarter and Attachment D beginning on page 55 details the matters from this quarter that OAH has not received any resolution session data.

MOTIONS

Prehearing motions and Notices of Insufficiency (NOIs) comprise a substantial amount of the work completed by administrative law judges. For this quarter, 337 prehearing motions and 32 NOIs were filed by the parties and ruled upon by OAH. Of the 337 prehearing motions that were ruled on by OAH, 76 were filed by students, 87 were filed by districts or other local

education agencies and 174 motions were stipulated.³¹ Of the 32 NOIs filed, 17 of the complaints were found sufficient, 12 were found insufficient, and three were found partially sufficient. Eight cases were dismissed for insufficiency after failing to amend the complaint.³²


There were 337 prehearing motions filed this quarter. Of the 76 motions filed by students, 48 were granted and 28 were denied. Of the 87 motions filed by districts or other local education agencies, 51 were granted, 29 were denied, and seven were granted in part. Of the 174 stipulated motions, 164 were granted, one was granted in part, and nine were denied.³³ The prehearing motions involved a variety of issues, with the largest number involving motions to continue (194 motions).

NON-ENGLISH-SPEAKING STUDENTS AND INTERPRETERS

During this quarter, 82 non-English-speaking students were identified through the due process hearing request forms.³⁴ Of the 82 non-English-speaking students, 71 students spoke Spanish, two spoke Farsi, two spoke Russian, two spoke Vietnamese, one spoke Japanese, one spoke Korean, one spoke Mandarin, one spoke Portugese, and one spoke Thai.

For the second quarter, OAH received 97 requests for the assistance of an interpreter at a hearing or mediation³⁵.

STUDENTS OF COLOR

CDE has requested that OAH collect data on the number of students of color accessing the system. To facilitate this request, OAH’s due process hearing request form asks the parties to voluntarily provide this information. However, not all hearing requests are made using the OAH form. This quarter, 10 students reported as being a student of color and six students reported as not being a student of color.³⁶ The remaining students did not state whether they were a student of color.



TRANSCRIPT REQUESTS AND APPEALS

Data on the number of appeals to state and federal courts and appellate outcomes are collected on an ongoing basis and include all cases that OAH was notified were appealed since July 2005. This quarter, OAH received 27 requests for transcripts, and was notified of one new appeal filed. Of the appeals reported in previous quarters, one OAH decision was dismissed, one was reversed, one appeal resulted in settlement, and one appeal was further appealed to a higher court.³⁷

Based on correspondence with the parties and filings that have been provided to OAH, 215 cases have been appealed since July 2005³⁸. Of the 215 cases that have been appealed, 51 have settled, 45 have been dismissed, 42 were upheld, four were remanded, eight were reversed, and seven were withdrawn. There are 15 cases that are currently on appeal. Of the cases that have been appealed, 43 have gone on to further appeal to a higher court.

A detailed list of cases that have been further appealed to a higher court can be found in Attachment F at page 68. Due to the difficulty in identifying which cases are appealed and the appellate outcomes, parties are invited to notify OAH of any case on appeal or any outcome on appeal that is not included in Attachment E or Attachment F.

MEDIATION AND HEARING EVALUATIONS

OAH is required to send evaluations to all parties attending mediations and hearings. The evaluations contain a rating scale of 1 to 5, with 1 being poor/very dissatisfied and 5 being excellent/extremely satisfied. The evaluations ask the parties to evaluate the mediation, the administrative law judge and OAH in general.

This quarter, 67 mediation evaluations were completed. Evaluations were completed by parents (11 cases), legal counsel for parents (nine cases), advocates for parents (six cases), school district representatives (34 cases), and legal counsel for districts (four cases). In three cases, the evaluator did not indicate his or her role in the mediation.
