The Interagency Agreement (IA) between the California Department of Education (CDE) and the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) requires OAH to report on a quarterly basis certain information related to mediations and due process and expedited hearings, as well as information required to be maintained according to state and federal law.<sup>1</sup> The following report addresses those IA reporting requirements.

### CASE FILINGS<sup>2</sup>

During the third quarter of fiscal year 2012-2013, OAH received 754 new case filings. For a comprehensive chart of the number of filings since 2005, please see Attachment A at page 21.

### CASES BY FILING PARTY

Overall, there were 754 total cases filed this quarter, which consisted of 635 student-filed cases and 119 district-filed cases.<sup>3</sup> Of the student-filed cases, 19 cases involved both expedited and non-expedited issues (dual hearings), and two cases that were exclusively expedited issues.<sup>4</sup> Of the district-filed cases, there were no cases that involved expedited issues or dual hearings.<sup>5</sup> Of the 754 cases filed, two requests by students and no requests by districts were for a due process hearing only. A detailed list of all student-filed cases this quarter broken down by district appears in Attachment B beginning on page 22.

Of the 754 cases opened by OAH this quarter, 752 requests were for mediation related to due process hearing or mediation-only.<sup>6</sup> Of the 752 requests for mediation, 52 were requests for mediation-only.<sup>7</sup> The remaining 700 requests for mediation were related to due process hearing requests.<sup>8</sup> Of the total requests for mediation, two student-filed cases involved expedited issues only, and 19 student-filed cases and no district-filed cases involved dual hearings.<sup>9</sup>



### LEGAL REPRESENTATION

During the third quarter, 754 cases were filed, which consisted of 635 student-filed requests and 119 district-filed requests. Of the 635 cases filed by students requesting due process, 533 cases (84 percent) were filed by attorneys; of the 119 district-filed cases, 80 cases (67 percent) were filed by attorneys.<sup>10</sup> Of the 754 cases filed this quarter, 613 cases (81 percent) were filed by attorneys. This fiscal year, 82 percent of student cases and 77 percent of district cases were filed with legal representation.



### GRADE LEVEL

The majority of the 754 cases filed this quarter originated from students in the primary grades (385 cases), followed by those in high school (174 cases), junior high school (114 cases) and preschool (65 cases). The grade level of the student was not specified in 16 of the case filings.<sup>11</sup>

### ISSUES AND REMEDIES

Cases filed this quarter involved a variety of issues and requested remedies. The number of issues raised varied per case, with some cases raising only one issue, and others raising


several issues. The most common issues raised in the 754 cases filed this quarter were designated instruction and services (471 cases) and placement (414 cases). Other issues included: assessment (384 cases), speech and language services (244 cases), occupational therapy services (161 cases), one-to-one aide services (132 cases), goals and objectives (128 cases), eligibility (64 cases), procedural violations (59 cases), extended school year services (56 cases), mental health services (48 cases), private services (38 cases), ABA (25 cases), and discipline (13 cases). Compensatory education was requested as a remedy in 333 cases and reimbursement was requested as a remedy in 273 cases.<sup>12</sup>


### ELIGIBILITY CATEGORY <sup>14</sup>

The majority of cases filed this quarter involved students identified under the eligibility category of Autistic-Like Behaviors (247 cases). Other identified areas of eligibility included: Specific Learning Disability (124 cases), Other Health Impaired (97 cases), Speech or Language Impairment (85 cases), Emotional Disturbance (53 cases), Orthopedic Impairment (21 cases), Intellectual Disability (17 cases), Hearing Impairment (six cases), Deafness (six cases), Visual Impairment (three cases), and Traumatic Brain Injury (one case). The student's area of eligibility was not identified in 181 cases.<sup>15</sup>



### CLOSED CASES

During this quarter, 711 cases were closed. Currently, 653 cases remain pending.<sup>16</sup> Of the 653 cases pending, 621 are related to due process hearing requests and 32 are related to mediation-only requests. Of the 711 cases closed, 672 were related to due process hearing requests and 39 were related to mediation-only requests. Of the 711 cases closed, 684 (96 percent) were resolved in some manner without need for a due process hearing.<sup>17</sup> For the fiscal year to date, 96 percent of cases have resolved without need for a due process hearing.



The majority of cases closed this quarter were settled during mediation (282 cases), followed by those that were resolved outside the mediation or resolution session process (256 cases), and those cases withdrawn by the filing party without explanation (98 cases). Additionally this quarter, 25 cases resolved during the resolution session<sup>18</sup>, 11 mediation-only cases were not settled at mediation, three cases were dismissed after failing to amend following a notice of insufficiency, three cases were dismissed by a motion to dismiss, two mediation-only cases were closed due to a party declining participation<sup>19</sup>, one case was closed for other reasons, and no cases closed at settlement conference. Out of the 711 cases closed this quarter, 27 were closed following a hearing and decision on the merits.



## MEDIATIONS

This quarter, 435 mediations were held. The mediations were held in cases opened this quarter and in cases that were pending from prior quarters. Of the 435 mediations held this quarter, in 80 cases an additional mediation session was scheduled. Of the 435 mediations held, 392 were related to due process hearing requests, three cases involved only expedited issues, five cases were related to a dual hearing request, and 35 were related to mediation-only requests.

For mediation requests related to due process hearing, 263 cases reached an agreement at mediation,<sup>20</sup> and 21 mediation-only cases reached an agreement,<sup>21</sup> for a total of 284 cases resulting in an agreement.<sup>22</sup> The one case involving only expedited issues reached an agreement at mediation. Of the three dual cases, which involved both expedited and non-expedited issues, which went to mediation, three reached an agreement.<sup>23</sup>

Out of the 435 mediations held this quarter, mediation was successful in 284 cases (65 percent), with 151 mediations resulting in impasse. At the end of this quarter, 381 cases have mediations pending,<sup>24</sup> and 621 cases have hearings pending.<sup>25</sup>





For the 2012-2013 fiscal year, OAH has conducted 1,335 mediations, with 865 resulting in an agreement and 470 resulting in impasse. The overall mediation success rate for fiscal year 2012-2013 is 65 percent. For the 2012-2013 fiscal year, 96 percent of cases have resolved without need for a due process hearing decision.



### DUE PROCESS HEARINGS

During the third quarter, out of the 711 cases closed, 27 final decisions were issued. Of the 27 decisions issued, 26 were issued within the 45-day timeline plus extensions, and no decisions were issued late.<sup>26</sup> There was one decision issued in a case with expedited issues and no changes of placement were ordered for this quarter.<sup>27</sup> Overall, this quarter, 100 percent of decisions were



issued within the requisite timeline. For the 2012-2013 fiscal year, OAH has issued 84 decisions and 99 percent have been issued within the requisite timelines.

Based upon the issues for hearing identified by the parties, students prevailed on all issues in four hearings (15 percent) and districts prevailed on all issues in 11 hearings (41 percent). In 12 of the 27 decisions issued (44 percent), the issues in the decision were split between student and district, with students prevailing on 22 issues and districts prevailing on 55 issues.<sup>28</sup> For the current fiscal year, students have prevailed on all issues in eight hearings (9 percent), districts have prevailed on all issues in 47 hearings (56 percent), and 29 cases (35 percent) resulted in a split decision of the issues. Copies of all decisions have been provided to CDE and have been posted on the OAH website.

On average, the due process hearings lasted five days, with students using 49 percent of the hearing time to present their cases and districts using 50 percent of hearing time for case presentation.<sup>29</sup> During case presentation, students called an average of seven witnesses per case and the districts called an average of seven witnesses per case.<sup>30</sup>

The hearings involved multiple areas of disability. The cases involved students identified with a disability area of Autistic-Like Behaviors (eight cases), Emotional Disturbance (six cases), Other Health Impaired (four cases), Specific Learning Disability (four case), Intellectual Disability (two cases), Multiple Disabilities (two cases), and in one case the student was found not eligible.

## RESOLUTION SESSIONS

The IDEA requires school districts to hold resolution sessions within 15 days of receipt of a student’s complaint. While there is no legal requirement to report this data to OAH, CDE requests that OAH track this information. Accordingly, OAH sends letters to school districts requesting them to report for each case if a resolution session was held, the outcome of each session, and other information about each session. This quarter, based on the information OAH received, 76 resolution sessions were reported as held and 236 were reported as not held. Of the 76 resolution sessions reported as held, three cases involved both expedited and non-expedited issues, with no sessions regarding an expedited case.<sup>31</sup> Attachment C, beginning on page 44, reports all resolution session information reported to OAH this quarter and Attachment D beginning on page 68 details the matters from this quarter that OAH has not received any resolution session data.

## MOTIONS

Prehearing motions and Notices of Insufficiency (NOIs) comprise a substantial amount of the work completed by administrative law judges. For this quarter, 319 prehearing motions and 29 NOIs were filed by the parties and ruled upon by OAH. Of the 319 prehearing motions that were ruled on by OAH, 48 were filed by students, 66 were filed by districts or other local education agencies and 205 motions were stipulated.<sup>32</sup> Of the 29 NOIs filed, 12 of the complaints were found sufficient, 14 were found insufficient, and three were found partially sufficient. Three cases were dismissed for insufficiency after failing to amend the complaint.<sup>33</sup>

There were 319 prehearing motions filed this quarter. Of the 48 motions filed by students, 33 were granted and 15 were denied. Of the 66 motions filed by districts or other local education agencies, 42 were granted, 21 were denied, two were granted in part, and one was deemed moot. Of the 205 stipulated motions, 195 were granted, nine were denied, and one was granted in part.<sup>34</sup> The prehearing motions involved a variety of issues, with the largest number involving motions to continue (212 motions).



### NON-ENGLISH-SPEAKING STUDENTS AND INTERPRETERS

During this quarter, 101 non-English-speaking students were identified through the due process hearing request forms.<sup>35</sup> Of the 101 non-English-speaking students, 92 students spoke Spanish, three spoke Farsi, three spoke Arabic, one spoke Vietnamese, one spoke Korean, and one spoke American Sign Language.

### STUDENTS OF COLOR

CDE has requested that OAH collect data on the number of students of color accessing the system. To facilitate this request, OAH’s due process hearing request form asks the parties to voluntarily provide this information. However, not all hearing requests are made using the OAH form. This quarter, six students reported as being a student of color and two students reported as not being a student of color.<sup>37</sup> The remaining students did not state whether they were a student of color.

### TRANSCRIPT REQUESTS AND APPEALS

Data on the number of appeals to state and federal courts and appellate outcomes are collected on an ongoing basis and include all cases that OAH was notified were appealed since July 2005. This quarter, OAH received 26 requests for transcripts, and was notified of two new appeals filed. Of the appeals reported in previous quarters, four OAH decisions were upheld, one appeal resulted in settlement, and one appeal was further appealed to a higher court.<sup>38</sup>


Based on correspondence with the parties and filings that have been provided to OAH, 215 cases have been appealed since July 2005<sup>39</sup>. Of the 217 cases that have been appealed, 52 have settled, 47 were upheld, 45 have been dismissed, eight were reversed, seven were withdrawn, and four were remanded. There are 11 cases that are currently on appeal. Of the cases that have been appealed, 43 have gone on to further appeal to a higher court.

A detailed list of cases on appeal and their outcomes after appeal is included in Attachment E beginning at page 81. A detailed list of cases that have been further appealed to a higher court can be found in Attachment F at page 86. Due to the difficulty in identifying which cases are appealed and the appellate outcomes, parties are invited to notify OAH of any case on appeal or any outcome on appeal that is not included in Attachment E or Attachment F.

### **MEDIATION AND HEARING EVALUATIONS**

OAH is required to send evaluations to all parties attending mediations and hearings. The evaluations contain a rating scale of 1 to 5, with 1 being poor/very dissatisfied and 5 being excellent/extremely satisfied. The evaluations ask the parties to evaluate the mediation, the administrative law judge and OAH in general.

This quarter, 71 mediation evaluations were completed. Evaluations were completed by parents (23 cases), legal counsel for parents (three cases), school district representatives (34 cases), and legal counsel for districts (11 cases). In no cases, did the evaluator not indicate his or her role in the mediation.

### **OVERALL AVERAGE MEDIATION RATING – 4.48**
