ORDER GRANTING STUDENT'S  
REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME  
TO FILE A RESPONSE TO THE  
DISTRICT'S MOTION TO DISMISS

On May 7, 2009, Parents on behalf of Student filed with the Office of Administrative Hearings, Special Education Division (OAH) a Request for Due Process Hearing (complaint), naming Corona-Norco Unified School District (District) as the respondent.

On August 19, 2009, the District filed with OAH a Motion to Dismiss Petitioner's Due Process Complaint with Prejudice (Motion to Dismiss).

On August 24, 2009, Parents filed with OAH an Opposition to Respondent's Motion to Dismiss and Motion for Extension. In the Motion for Extension, Parents requested an Order that allowed Parents to file a response to the Motion to Dismiss by August 26, 2009.

The District has not opposed the Motion for Extension. Accordingly, the Motion for Extension shall be granted. Due to the length of the Motion to Dismiss, Parents and Student shall have until Friday, August 28, 2009, to file a response to the Motion to Dismiss.

ORDER

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, the request for extension of time to file a response to the District's Motion to Dismiss is granted. Any response shall be filed by August 28, 2009.
