ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR
TELEPHONIC TESTIMONY

On December 20, 2010, Student filed a motion requesting that witness Brad Simpson be permitted to testify by telephone in the due process hearing in this matter. The Saddleback Valley Unified School District filed a notice of non-opposition on December 23, 2010, requesting only that Student be required to provide Mr. Simpson with copies of exhibits from both parties should Student's motion be granted.

Student's motion is granted. Student is ordered to provide Mr. Simpson with copies of Student's evidence packet and the District's evidence packet prior to the time he will testify. Mr. Simpson will not be permitted to testify by telephone if he does not have the exhibits with him at the time he is called to testify. Since the hearing in this matter is scheduled to take place at the District's offices, the District is requested to have a telephone with a speaker available on the day Mr. Simpson is scheduled to testify. Student is directed

to confer with the District prior to the start of the hearing and inform the District of the day and time she intends to call Mr. Simpson as a witness.
