ORDER FOR SUPPLEMENTAL
BRIEFING ON MOTION FOR STAY
PUT

On April 4, 2011, Parent on behalf of Student (Student) filed a Motion for Stay Put, asserting that Student is entitled to stay put services including two hours per week of pre-kindergarten itinerant services (PKIT). On April 6, 2011, the District filed a partial opposition to Student's motion asserting that Student's last IEP only provided two hours per month of PKIT services. Neither party provided a copy of Student's last written IEP or any documentation to support their contradicting contentions regarding the PKIT services. The District did not dispute the remaining provisions of Student's stay put request.

ORDER

Within five days of this order, each party shall provide a copy of Student's last IEP on which they rely in their arguments on stay put, or a stipulation between the parties indicating the agreed upon stay put provision regarding the PKIT services. Each party shall include sworn declarations supporting any factual assertions included in its briefing.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
