ORDER DENYING MOTION TO  
QUASH SUBPOENAS AND SETTING  
NEW COMPLIANCE DATES FOR  
SUBPOENAS

On September 1, 2011, Parent on behalf of Student (Student) filed a Due Process Request (complaint) naming the Culver City Unified School District (District) as respondent. On October 11, 2011, Student filed motions to quash subpoenas served by the District on UCLA Lab School (UCLA) and the Child Success Center (CSC) requiring a representative to appear personally and produce records on October 27, 2011, the date scheduled for the due process hearing. The District filed its opposition to the motions on October 13, 2011. Student requested that the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) grant it additional time to respond to the District's opposition.

On October 18, 2011, Student filed a motion for leave to file an amended complaint, which OAH granted on October 24, 2011. On October 25, 2011, OAH issued an order scheduling the due process hearing for December 19, 2011.

On October 26, 2011, Student filed an amended motion to quash the subpoenas served on UCLA and CSC on grounds that the subpoenas contain the wrong date for the due processing hearing. The District filed its opposition to the amended motion on October 31, 2011.

Student's motion is DENIED. The compliance date of the subpoenas shall be December 19, 2011, the date of the due process hearing. The District shall notify UCLA and CSC of the new compliance date and provide a copy of this order to the subpoenaed parties.
