ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR  
FILING SECOND AMENDED  
COMPLAINT

On February 1, 2012, Parent filed a First Amended Complaint in these consolidated matters. On February 16, 2012, the San Luis Obispo County Office of Education (SLOCOE) filed a Notice of Insufficiency as to the First Amended Complaint. On February 17, 2012, OAH ruled most of the First Amended Complaint insufficient, gave Parent 14 days to amend, and suggested that Parent request a mediator to assist her in redrafting her complaint. That ruling was served on February 21, 2012. Accordingly, a second amended complaint would need to be filed no later than March 6, 2012.

On February 23, 2012, Parent requested the assistance of a mediator in redrafting her complaint. On February 29, 2012, Parent moved for a two-day extension of time, to and including February 8, 2012, to file a second amended complaint. The grounds for the motion were that the order granting 14 days to amend was not served until four days after it was filed; that Parent had obtained the services of a mediator in redrafting her complaint; and that conclusion of that process would require an additional two days.

On March 1, 2012, the Lucia Mar Unified School District informed OAH that it would not oppose the motion. SLOCOE did not respond to the motion.

The motion is timely and demonstrates good cause for the extension sought. Parent's time to file a Second Amended Complaint is extended to the close of business on March 8, 2012. Parent is encouraged to serve the Second Amended Complaint on the District and

SLOCOE by facsimile or other means allowing them to read the second amended complaint before the status conference on March 9, 2012, which will be set by separate order.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
