ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR

On June 14, 2012, Parent, on behalf of Student, filed with the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) a motion to continue the currently scheduled hearing dates, based upon lack of ability to prepare for the hearing, and the need to hire an attorney. On June 15, 2012, counsel for the District filed with OAH a non-opposition to the request, conceding that good cause existed for a continuance.

A due process hearing must be conducted and a decision rendered within 45 days of receipt of the due process notice unless an extension is granted for good cause. (34 C.F.R. § 300.515(a) & (c) (2006); Ed. Code, §§ 56502, subd. (f), 56505, subd. (f)(3); Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1020.)

OAH has reviewed the request for good cause and considered all relevant facts and circumstances. The request is: Granted. All dates are vacated. This matter will be set as follows:
