ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO
RESET TIMELINES AND VACATING
DATES

On February 5, 2013, Student filed a Due Process Complaint (Complaint) in this matter with the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). On March 11, 2013, Folsom Cordova Unified School District (District) filed a Motion to Change Timelines because the complaint was not served on District and it does not have a copy of the complaint. Student did not file a response to the motion.

The District alleges that it has not received a copy of the complaint or the scheduling order from OAH in this matter. The District office is currently located at 1965 Birkmont Drive, Rancho Cordova, CA 95742. The scheduling order from OAH was sent to the District's previous address on Gadsten Way, in Rancho Cordova, CA. Student's complaint indicates that it was also sent to the Gadsten Way address. The District alleges that it was not aware of this matter until March 8, 2013, when an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) from OAH called to confirm mediation in this matter. The District filed this motion to reset timelines in this matter to allow the District the opportunity to participate in a resolution session and timely address the complaint. The Motion is GRANTED.

ORDER

1. Within the ten business days of the date of this Order, Student shall properly serve a copy of the complaint on District at 1965 Birkmont Drive, Rancho Cordova, CA 95742.
2. Student shall contemporaneously serve a copy of the complaint on OAH showing proof of service to District at the correct address. At that time, OAH will issue a new scheduling order in this matter.
3. All dates in currently scheduled in this matter are VACATED.

4. Should Student fail to serve the complaint on the District at the correct address within ten business days, the District may move to dismiss this matter.
