ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR
STAY PUT

On March 4, 2013, Parents on behalf of Student (Student) filed with the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) a Request for Due Process hearing (complaint) naming the El Rancho Charter School and the Orange Unified School (collectively referred to as District) as respondents. In the caption of the complaint, Student refers to a motion for stay put. The complaint omits any such motion.

On March 7, 2013, District filed an opposition to the motion on grounds that Student has failed to meet its burden, by failing to allege any facts or legal argument, to support the motion.

Since Student has failed to offer any grounds to support its motion, Student's motion for stay put is DENIED without prejudice.
