ORDER FOR SUPPLEMENTAL  
INFORMATION IN SUPPORT OF  
STUDENT'S REQUEST TO  
RESCHEDULE HEARING

On June 12, 2013, the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) received a letter from Student asking OAH to reschedule a due process hearing that is to begin on August 20, 2013. In his letter to OAH, Student says that his legal counsel in this matter, Peter Sturges, is on vacation, and Student implies that Mr. Sturges asked him to contact OAH himself about a June 3 2013, request for continuation of that due process hearing that West Sonoma County Union High School District and Santa Rosa City Schools (collectively referred to as the Districts) sent to OAH. The Districts have asked OAH to continue that August 20, 2013 due process hearing.<sup>1</sup>

In his letter to OAH, Student asks that the due process hearing in this matter be advanced to an earlier date in August due to the fact that he is scheduled to begin community college classes on August 19, 2013. However, there is no indication that the Districts, through their attorney, were served with a copy of Student's letter.

ORDERS

Within five days of this order, Student shall serve the Districts with a copy of his letter dated June 11, 2013, (received by OAH on June 12, 2013), and shall provide OAH with a proof of service to that effect.
