ORDER VACATING STATUS
CONFERENCE AND RESETTING
INITIAL HEARING DATES

On April 2, 2013, the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) issued a Notice of Telephonic Status Conference in this matter, vacating the initially scheduled mediation and hearing dates in the case, and setting a Status Conference for June 5, 2013. This action was taken based upon a Notice of Resolution Outcome submitted to OAH by counsel for the San Juan Unified School District, which indicated that the parties had entered into an interim agreement in the matter.

However, on April 16, 2013, counsel for Student submitted to OAH a letter which stated that the Notice of Telephonic Status Conference was issued in error, and which requested that OAH reinstate the vacated dates. On the same day, counsel for the District submitted to OAH a response to Student's request, contending that the parties really had reached an interim agreement.

It is obvious that the parties do not have the same understanding about what transpired at the Resolution Session in this matter, such that OAH must vacate the Status Conference date of June 5, 2013, and reinstate the hearing dates in this matter, as follows:

Mediation:	To be determined by the parties.
Prehearing Conference:	04/22/2013, at 1:30 p.m.
Due Process Hearing:	05/09/2013, and continuing day to day, Monday through Thursday, as needed at the discretion of the Administrative Law Judge.
